Liability Disclaimer

General

All those entering the SAA site do so at their own risk.

The SAA does not provide liability insurance in respect of personal belongings, sheds, shed contents or equipment. Any loss or damage arising from whatever cause is the liability of the SAA member.

Bonfires

The following rules must be followed in respect of the lighting of bonfires and failure to do so will result in any damage arising being for the liability of the SAA member responsible :

1) the bonfire is attended at all times by a responsible adult and is lit:

a. without the use of any accelerant and well away from any highly flammable liquids or items such as gas cylinders and fuel cans

b. within Your allotment where there is a shovel nearby with sufficient water to extinguish it

c. in a cleared area where there are no overhanging branches with minimal grass and scrub and a safe distance from all property including buildings, equipment, fences and vehicles and no less than ten metres from any property located outside Your boundary

and

2) the bonfire is fully extinguished with water when You have finished with it. You must not use sand or dirt for this purpose instead.

Bees

It should be noted that bee hives are present on the Allotment Site and members or their guests with bee sting allergies should take whatever precautions they deem necessary.
